Toyota Manufacturing - Each year, the top five volunteers are selected by an Advisory Committee to receive cash awards for their charities and are invited to a recognition dinner. These top five volunteers have worked 150+ hours during the year and are selected for the diversity in their volunteer time. Four of the top volunteers receive \$1,500 each for their selected charities and the Volunteer of Year receives the President's Award and \$3000 for their selected charity. Team members are asked to log their volunteer activities and hours as an added recognition for team members. Each month three team members are randomly selected and a \$200 donation is given to those volunteers' charities of choice.
